- Participation in conferencing for three reports/learning plans per year
- Development and presentation of three student portfolios of work samples demonstrating knowledge/understanding supporting Ministry mandated curriculum and other enrichment areas
- Participation in the Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) testing for grades 4 and 7
- Maintaining regular contact with teacher – averaging twice a month - e-mail, phone, direct contact
- Active daily involvement of parents in child’s learning
